Playoff seeding will be determined as follows:

1. Best record. If still tied then:
2. Head to head. (Not used if all teams tied did not play each other or all beat each other) If still tied then:
3. Least runs allowed. If still tied then:
4. Runs Scored If still tied then:
5. Coin flip.

2 POINTS FOR A WIN, 1 POINT FOR A TIE, AND 0 POINTS A LOSS.

Coin toss to determine home team in each game. In playoffs, higher seed will be home team until championship game which will be determined by coin flip.

Games will be 6 Innings with no new inning after 1:45; Extra innings are played if there is still time on the clock. If time expires in a tie game in pool play, game is called a tie. 5 RUNS PER INNING RULE SHALL BE IN EFFECT WITH 6TH INNING OPEN.

Teams may also bat their entire roster.

No courtesy runner allowed. No stealing or advancing on overthrows allowed.

Each player on roster must play at least 2 innings per game. No player shall play more than 2 innings at any defensive position per game. 11 player maximum allowed on defense. Each offensive player shall receive a maximum of 6 pitches per at bat. Swing 3rd strike shall be declared an out.

Advancing base runners must be half way to base to continue to advance. Once defensive infield position has possession of the ball all play is stopped. THESE CALLS ARE ALL AT THE UMPIRES DISCRETION.

California tie breaker will be used in the championship game if needed.
