Playoff seeding will be determined as follows:

Games will be 6 Innings with no new inning after 1:45; Extra innings are played if there is still time on the clock. If time expires in a tie game in pool play, game is called a tie. 10 run mercy rule will apply after 5 innings.

Courtesy runner allowed for catcher only with 2 outs. Courtesy runner must be sub or last out.

Pitching Restrictions: 4 innings per day, 6 innings total, per pitcher for the tournament. 1 inning added for championship. Teams may bat 9 players and or bat 10 players with the 10th player being an EH. The EH is considered a defensive player and may switch in and out defensively. Teams may also bat their entire roster.

California tie breaker will be used in the championship game if needed.
